RAIN BARREL ORDER FORM

The Morgan County Soil and Water Conservation District is pleased to offer rain barrels for sale through Upcycle Products, Inc. Upcycle Products, Inc. uses Food Quality High Density Poly Ethylene Barrels that were previously used to ship pickled food overseas. They clean and rinse them with water and PH neutral soap so you never have to worry about harsh containments getting on your plants.

The barrels come with a two-piece lid, like a mason jar with a screen on it. There are three holes drilled into the lid for the water to drain into from your downspout. The screening keeps out the debris from the roof and keeps the mosquitoes out. The screening is easily removed for cleaning by unscrewing the outer ring of the lid.

A white downspout diverter is included to tie into your existing gutter downspouts. The diverter will fit standard 2"x3" downspouts and includes a 40 inch long hose to carry the rainwater to the rain barrel.

All of these barrels have a garden hose size spigot at the bottom to allow you to have several options on how to water your plants. A garden hose, landscape tubing, or drip tubing can be attached to the barrel. No additional accessories are included (additional fittings, hoses, riser stand, etc.)
